

HAVING read the documents filed of record and having considered the matter:-

THE COURT GRANTS AN ORDER:-

- 1. Dispensing with the forms, service and time periods prescribed in terms of the Uniform Rules of Court, and directing that the matter is heard as one of urgency in terms of Rule 6(12) of the Uniform Rules of Court.
- 2. Dispensing with the citation requirements in Rule 6(12) in respect of the Seventh Respondents.
- 3. The Respondents or any other interested person/s are directed to show cause on 01 February 2016 at 10:00am in Court why the following order should not be made final:-
 - 3.1 interdicting and restraining the Respondents and/or any other persons participating in protest action on the Applicant's precinct from:
 - unlawfully occupying Senate House or any other offices. buildings, facilities or lecture halls within the Applicant's precinct;
 - 3.1.2 in any way disrupting the normal activities of the Applicant, including registration, classes, lectures, tutorials and the like;



- 3.1.3 obstructing or preventing any person from entering or leaving the precinct of the Applicant or any of its buildings, facilities, residences, halls, classrooms and the like;
- 3.1.4 in any way causing damages to the property of the Applicant, its staff or students;
- 3.1.5 participating in, calling for, inciting or encouraging unlawful behaviour;
- 3.1.6 harassing, intimidating, threatening or assaulting any of the Applicant's students or staff or service providers, or members of the public in any manner whatsoever;
- 3.1.7 carrying firearms or dangerous weapons defined in the Dangerous Weapons Act 15 of 2013, or knives or sticks of any kind on the Applicant's precinct;
- 3.2 directing the South African Police Service and/or Public Order Policing Unit to assist the Applicant in enforcing this order and to take steps or measures that are necessary to ensure compliance with this order and to maintain law and order at the Applicant's premises.
- Service of this Court order is to be effected in the same manner as the 4. application was served, which is set out below:-
 - 4.1 emailing a copy of the application directly to the First to Sixth Respondents;
 - affixing copies of this application to various notice boards at the main 4.2 entrances to the Applicant's precincts.
