Where can I find my exam results?	You can find your exam results on the Wits self-service or on the following link: http://self-service.wits.ac.za . Please consult your Faculty should you not be able to access your results.
What happens if I have failed?	If you have been excluded (code MRNM) you may want to appeal the decision by applying to the Wits Readmissions Committee (WRC). This Committee takes into consideration your year marks, motivational letter and makes a decision whether to allow you to be readmitted. The WRC procedures booklet is available on the following link: http://www.wits.ac.za/students/exams/results .
Where do I get the WRC forms?	The WRC form needs to be completed and submitted on-line. The on-line form can be found on your Student Self-service portal. The navigation is as follows: Main Menu>Self Service>Student Self Service>Application for WRC .
By when do I apply?	The on-line WRC form needs to be completed and submitted on-line as per the deadlines published on Faculty notice boards and on the notice boards in Solomon Mahlangu House.
Can I apply to the WRC with outstanding fees?	You will be allowed to apply to the WRC. However you will not be able to register until you have made arrangements to settle any outstanding fees.
When is the last day that I can register for my degree?	The last day for registration differs among Faculties and programmes. It is your responsibility to find out from your Faculty office when the last day of registration is for your programme and to register on or before that date.
I am a first year student. Can I register late?	The University cannot guarantee your place if you do not register on the day set aside for your programme. If there are special circumstances for you being unable to register on time please submit a written request to the Registrar@wits.ac.za who will inform you if this has been accepted.

If you are a NSFAS student you will not be required to pay. If you cannot afford to make first payment before enrolment, please access the self-service portal https://self-service.wits.ac.za to acknowledge that you can only make payment by the end of March 2019, by which time your fees should be settled in full or an Acknowledgement of Debt should be signed.</p> <p>All international students including asylum seekers are required to pay 75% of the annual tuition fee, related costs and on-campus accommodation (where applicable) on or before registration. The balance of the fees is payable by the end of March 2019.</p> <p>Students owing R10 000 or less from prior year debt will be able to roll over the debt and register in 2019. If you fall into the following categories you may apply for registration assistance by paying 50% of outstanding debt and signing an AOD-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. If you enrolled prior to 2018 and has a total household income below R600 000 (GAP funding defined limit) b. If you enrolled since 2018 – household income between R350 000 (NSFAS limit) and R600 000. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you have been awarded an external bursary or scholarship. Please present proof to FASO. • If you have been given a University Scholarship • Applied for the first fee payment plan (as noted above).
