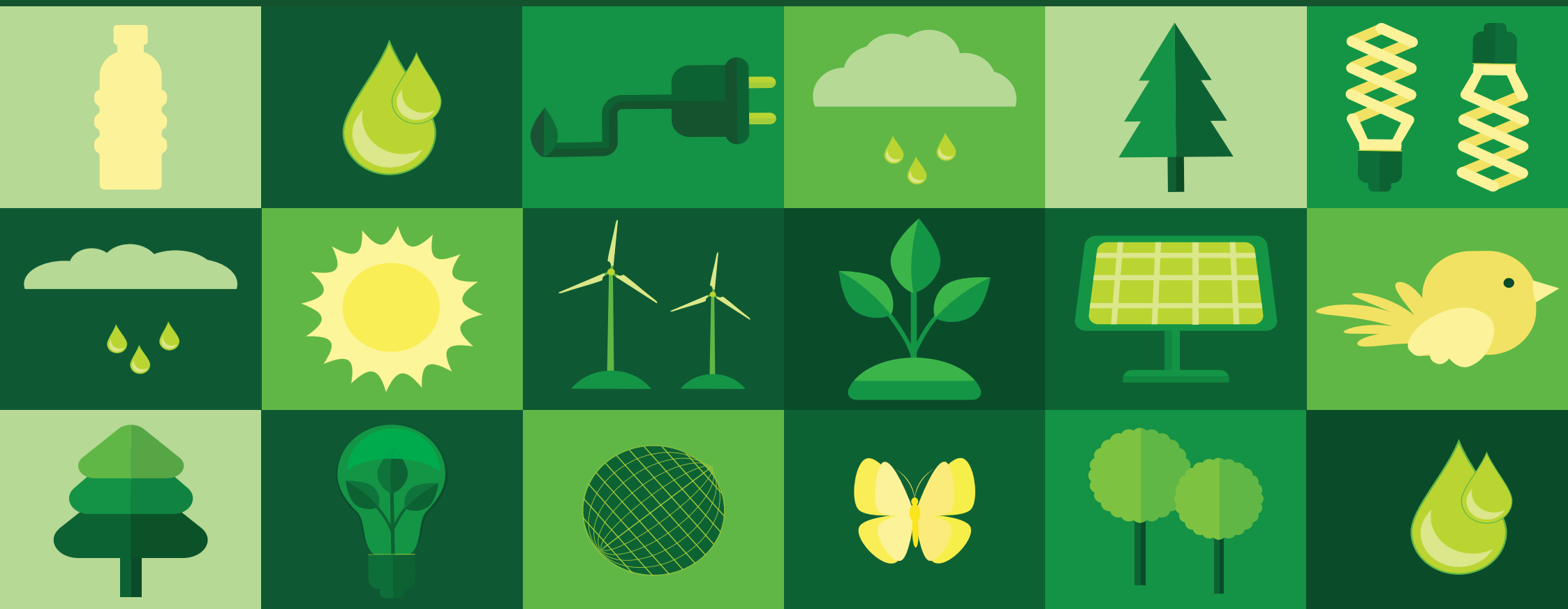




# THE PARIS AGREEMENT AT A CROSSROADS: PATHWAYS TO A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE

## SPEAKER BIO:

Professor Sir David King is an internationally renowned leader in global climate action. He was born in South Africa and educated at the University of the Witwatersrand. He serves as Emeritus Professor of Chemistry at the University of Cambridge, Chair of the Climate Crisis Advisory Group (CCAG), and Founder of the Centre for Climate Repair at Cambridge. Throughout his career, Sir David has held numerous positions, and has played an important role in the UK climate governance as UK Government's Chief Scientific Adviser (2000–2007) and Foreign Secretary's Special Representative on Climate Change (2013 to 2017). A Fellow of the Royal Society since 1991 and a Foreign Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences (2002), Sir David was knighted in 2003.
