

New Postgraduate Course

MSc Med in Genomic Medicine Coursework & Research report

About the Degree

This is a 1-year fulltime MSc in Genomic Medicine, offered through the Division of Human Genetics, School of Pathology in the Faculty of Health Sciences.

The MSc includes coursework covered through 6 modules, as well as a research project (30% of final mark).

The course will provide foundational knowledge and skills development necessary for genomic research in the context of human disease in Africa.

- 1. Research Methodology
- 2. Fundamentals of Human Genetics and Genomics
- 3. Omics Techniques & Application in Genomic Medicine
- 4. Genomics of Common and Rare Diseases
- 5. Bioinformatics Analysis & Interpretation of Genomics Sequencing Data
- 6. Precision Medicine
