HOW TO READ THE TIMETABLE AND FIRST LECTURE DOCUMENT

<u>Timetable</u>

The timetable is divided into two semesters. In each of the semesters you will follow the timetable as indicated.

On the left-hand side of the timetable, you will see the days of the week as well as a list of all programmes. At the top of the timetable you will see the timeslots.

Locate the programme for which you have registered.

The timetable indicates the day and time for each of the courses for which you have registered for. It contains the course code only as well as a descriptor of the session i.e. LABS / LECT / PRAC etc. (please refer to the footnotes for the full description). The full name of the course is included in the following document.

Alt – this means that these courses follow the same time slots but in alternative weeks.

First Lecture and Course Coordinator / Lecturer Information

This document contains information about the first time that you will have interaction with the course coordinator / lecturer/s for each of your courses.

Against each of your courses, you will see the date, time and format (online or face-to-face) of the first meeting. During these sessions, you will receive pertinent course information for the rest of the year.

The document also includes the names and contact details of the course coordinator / lecturer/s for each of the courses.
