- To determine the proximity to the university, the evaluation will consider the distance between the tenderer's office location and Braamfontein, where the university is situated. The statement specifies that tenderers must have offices within 50km of Braamfontein for ICT tenderers and 80km for Health and Safety Tenderers, indicating a broader geographical scope
