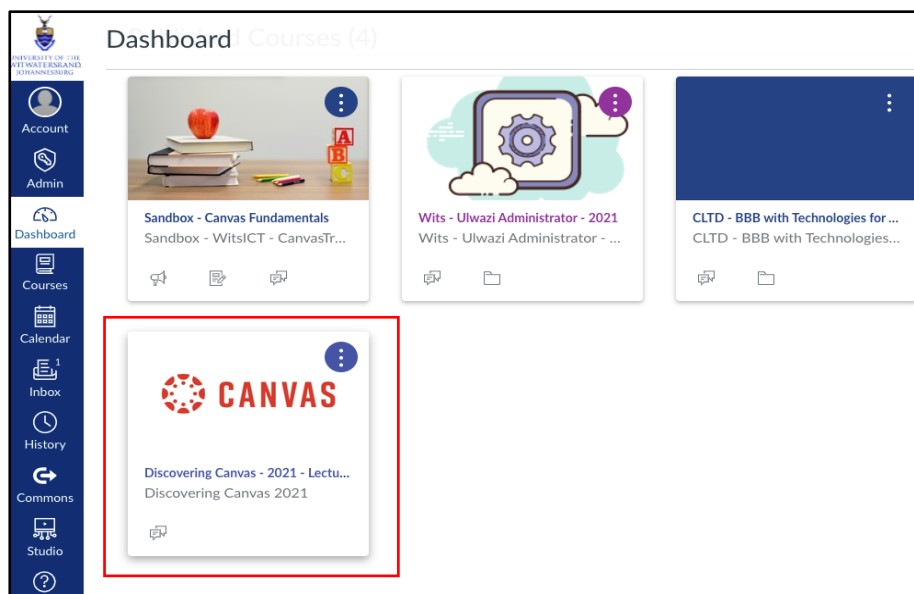


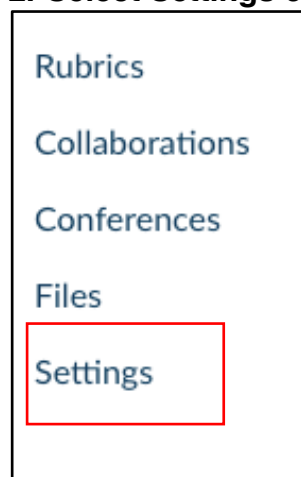
How to make your Course Site Self-enrollable and Visible on the Public Course Index

To enable the Self-Enroll option in a Course site (Project Site) in ulwazi

1. In your Dashboard select your Course site



2. Select Settings on the Course Menu (lower left side of your Course Menu)



3. Select Course details

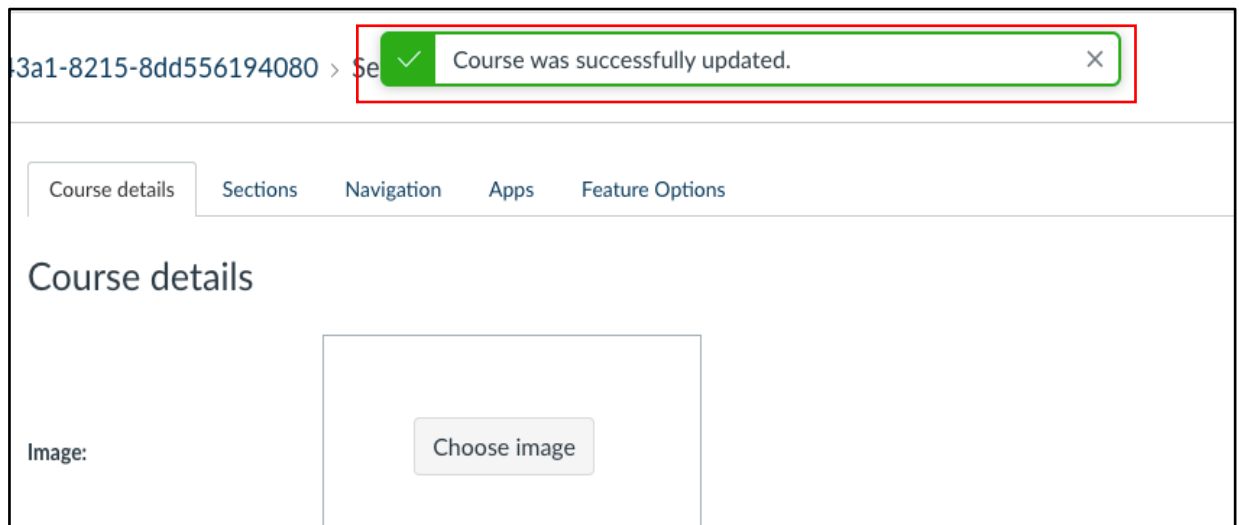

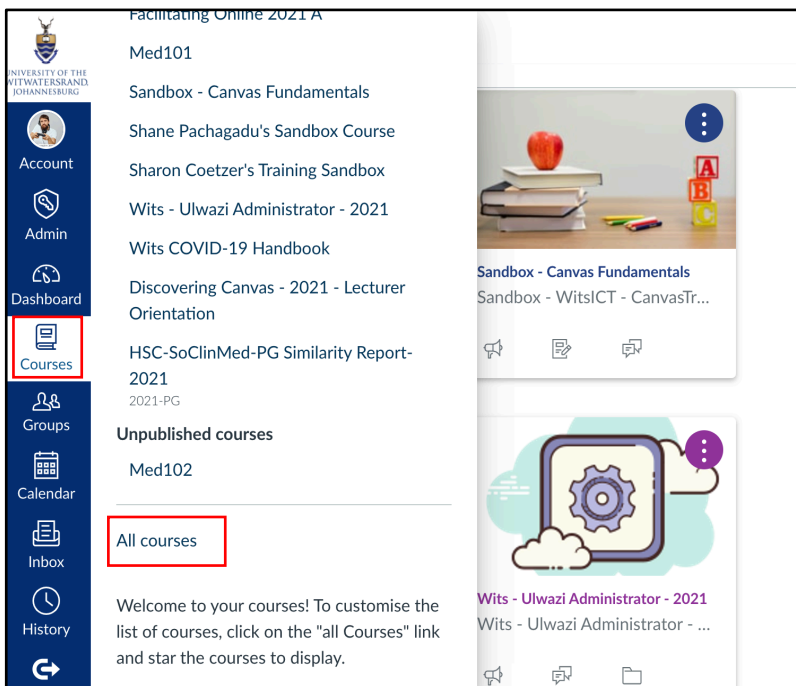

To find a course site on the Public Course Index

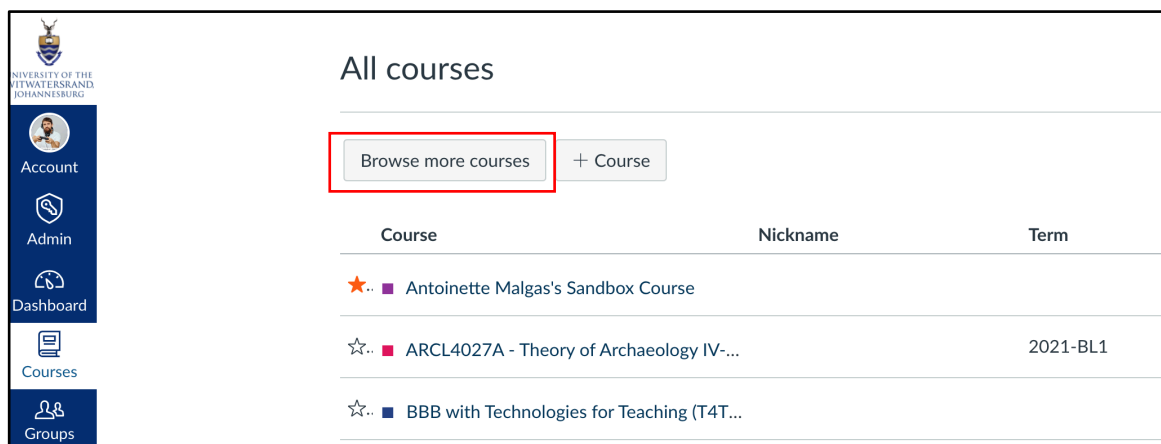
The Public Course Index allows all users within the university to publicly view the institution's course index in a catalog format. **These could be project sites that have been made available by owners for users to view and if enabled allow users to enroll into.** You can view a link to the Public Course Index on the My Courses page.

1. To find and access course sites that are made public, follow these steps:

- >Click on>**Courses** on the Global Navigation Menu
- >Scroll down>**All courses**



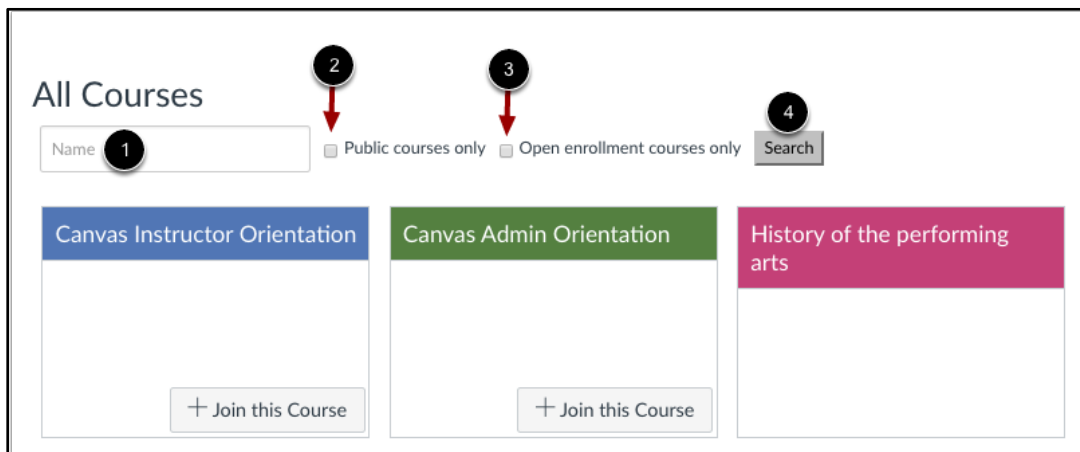
2. >Select>**Browse more courses**

3. Search for courses



You can search for courses in several different ways. In the Name field [1], you can type the name of a course.

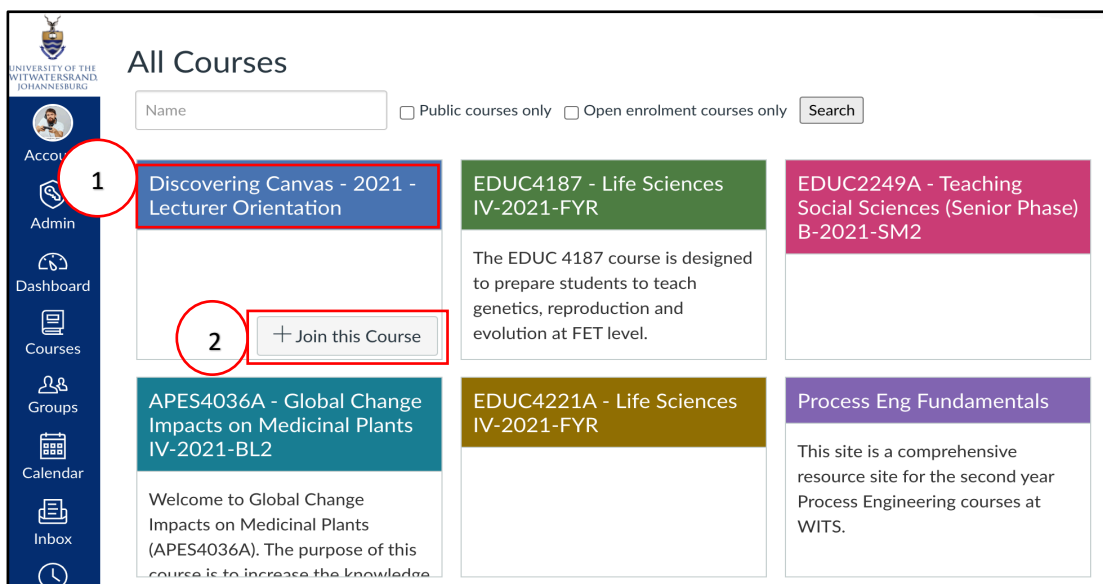
You can also search for courses by status. If you want to view only public courses, click the **Public courses only** checkbox [2]. If you want to view only open enrollment courses, click the **Open enrollment courses only** checkbox [3]. Open enrollment courses are courses that you can join at any time.

When you are finished selecting your search options, click the **Search** button [4]

4. View and enrol into courses

>View course> click on **1**

>if the course is made self-enrollable>click on **2** **+ Join this Course**
