# The University of Tübingen: Facts and Figures

- Founded in **1477** and thus one of the oldest universities in Germany
- Approx. **27,000 students** (winter semester 2020-21)
- **700 doctorates** conferred annually
- **Comprehensive research university**  
(with a focus on Medicine, Humanities, Social Sciences)
- **“University of Excellence”** status
- 8 Nobel Prize Winners

## Study Options

**More than 280 study programs in 130 subject areas:**

- **Innovative study programs**

e.g. Medical Technology, Molecular Medicine, Environmental Science, Geoecology, Nanoscience, Media Studies, Computer Science, Sports Management, Islamic Theology

- **International study programs (mainly taught in English)**

e.g. Neuro- and Behavioral Science, Applied Environmental Geoscience, Computer Linguistics, International Economics and Business Administration

# International Exchange in Tübingen

## Academics

- Wide range of **English-taught classes** on undergraduate and graduate level, e.g. in Business and Economics, Social Sciences, Natural Sciences etc.

- Division for German as a Foreign Language and Intercultural Programs offers a wide range of **courses in German language and culture**
- German language courses usually start at B1 level, some at A 2
- Combine German language and culture classes with regular University courses
- Basic knowledge of German is recommended, but no prerequisite to be accepted

## Academic Calendar

### Winter Semester

- Middle of October → middle of February

### Summer Semester

- Middle of April → end of July

### **Orientation programs** in September and March

- General orientation program (1 week)
- 3-week language course with orientation part (300 €)
- Intensive 5-week language course (825 €)
