- *IF NOT YET: You must register for EDUC1260A ICT Literacy -Timetable slot: F1 (GEN)*

##### 4.2. Are you able to hold a conversation in a Black South African language (Sesotho, isiZulu, isiNdebele, isiXhosa, Sepedi, Setswana, SiSwati, Tshivenda, or Xitsonga or South African Sign Language)?

- *IF YES: Bring documentary evidence of your competence in the language or participate in an interview to verify your language competence. You may be exempt from learning a new language. Proceed to 3.3.*
- *If NOT YET: You will need to register for one of the following courses, either this year or next year (if you are already registered for ICT Literacy this year)*
  - EDUC1265A isiZulu (Conversational Competence) - Timetable Slot: D1 (GEN)
  - EDUC1266A Sesotho (Conversational Competence) - Timetable Slot: (GEN)
  - EDUC1272A South African Sign Language (Conversational Competence) - Timetable Slot D1 (GEN)
- *If you have communicative competence in English and Afrikaans, but not a Black South African language, you may apply to have your communicative competence acknowledged on your degree certificate. Bring the documentary evidence but note that you will still be required to learn another language, as per the requirements of the legislation governing initial teacher education in South Africa.*

##### 4.3. IF you do NOT need to register for ICT Literacy NOR a Language (Conversational competence) this year, then you may choose to do one of the following enrichment electives:
