

If you have a desire to study Law at Wits, we recommend that you consider the following options, taking into account the entry requirements, and your field of interest:

- Bachelor of Arts (BA) (ABA00) – no Law modules, apply for the **three year** LLB programme on completion of this degree.
- Bachelor of Arts with Law (BA Law) (ABA02) – Wits students only - apply for the **two year** LLB programme on completion of this degree
- Bachelor of Commerce (BCom) (CBA00) - no Law modules, apply for the **three year** LLB programme on completion of this degree.
- Bachelor of Commerce with Law (BCom Law) (CBA13) - apply for the **two year** LLB programme on completion of this degree.
- **Bachelor of Laws (LLB)** four-year professional degree (LFA14)

**The three year LLB (LFA13, Year of Study 2):** for applicants who have completed a first degree, e.g. Bachelor of Arts (BA), Bachelor of Commerce (BCom), where no Law courses have been completed, or

**The two year LLB (LFA12, Year of Study 3):** for Wits students who have completed a first degree where Law has been taken as a major course.
